Then it so happened that we got the keys to our new house the SAME DAY as we were meant to be out of our rented house! All the paperwork and legal details had been completed within that four week period! Only God could have orchestrated that. And the new house and the area turned out to be much better than the house we had originally nearly bought. We enjoyed living there for many years.

Calm in a particularly chaotic house move

We bought a new house and moved in January 2021 (so in the depths of the third UK lockdown). Throughout the process we prayed that God would be with us and look after us.

On the day, packing up and moving out of our old house went smoothly, but it became clear that the legal side of things was taking longer than it should have done. It turned out that our buyer, who had advertised as a cash buyer, had changed their mind and was now selling something as part of the purchase. The solicitors for this sale didn't complete their legal side of things until nearly 3 hours later than they should have done, having a knock-on effect in the sale chain. Then, the solicitors for the people we were buying from went home early, despite the sale not being completed. We no longer owned our old house, but neither did we own our new house yet - we were stuck in the middle limbo.

We were at risk of being without a home for a night and needing our belongings to be stored in a van in the mover's yard, except the person we were buying from (who was moving into an empty house) had been allowed in to that house to move their stuff. They called us saying they were moved out, so if we wanted we could come and claim the keys even though we didn't legally own the property at that point. Thus, we were able to move our things into our new house, and be secure in our new home even before the solicitors were finally able to complete the legal aspect of things at 12pm the next day (almost 24 hours after it should have been completed). One of our movers commented that in over 15 years of moving houses, he had never seen delays and problems with solicitors quite like this.

Not only was God able to get us into our house on the day we moved, even if legally it wasn't ours at that point, but throughout the whole process, despite becoming more and more legally vulnerable with the threat of temporary homelessness very real, we had an incredible peace about the whole process. We are the kind of people who could well have fretted and panicked when it became clear things weren't going as they should, but we didn't. We were able to sit in our car in a Tesco's car park listening to podcasts and be fully confident that this was in God's hands and He was looking after us.

House Sale


